

Proposed Local Coverage Determination for Botulinum Toxin Injections

Medicare coverage is divided into geographical regions, each managed by a **Medicare Administrative Contractor (MAC)**. These MACs are responsible for developing **Local Coverage Determinations (LCD)**, which decide whether a particular item or service will be covered in their specific region.
